***A Resolution Establishing the Goals and Directives of the Office of Personal Prosperity for the Year 2026***

**WHEREAS,**

the Office of Personal Prosperity (“OPP”) recognizes the need to establish clear objectives to guide labor, financial, educational, travel, and housing pursuits during the calendar year 2026; and

**WHEREAS,**

the OPP affirms that the pursuit of stability, growth, and prosperity requires measurable goals, prudent timelines, and the accountability of designated boards and committees; and

**WHEREAS,**

the goals set forth herein shall be known collectively as **Directive Resolution 264 (“DR-264”)**; and

**WHEREAS,**

any modification, amendment, or repeal of these goals shall only be enacted by a duly approved resolution of the OPP;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**Section I – Employment Goals**

1. **Full-Time Employment:** The OPP shall determine whether a salary increase from the State of Kansas is forthcoming. If not, separation from current employment shall be considered. The Labor Review Board shall issue its determination no later than **May 1, 2026, but no earlier than February 7th, 2026.**
2. **Salary Target:** By **December 1, 2026**, the annual full-time income target shall not be less than **\$55,000 per year** or **\$26.45 per hour**, regardless of employer.

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Section II – Financial Goals

1. **Expense Limitation:** Monthly living and general expenses shall not exceed **\$900.00**.
  - All general expenses are to be tracked.
2. **Debt Repayment:**
  - Chase Balance: Paid in full or maintained at zero by **May 2026**.
  - PayPal Balance: Paid in full or maintained at zero by **June 2026**.
  - Affirm-2 Balance: Paid in full by **January 2026**.
  - Discover Loan: Paid in full by **August 2026**.
  - Jeep Loan: Paid in full by **December 2026**.
3. **Emergency Savings:** A dedicated **Emergency Fund** of no less than **\$3,000** shall be established by **December 2026**.
4. **Business Development:** Establish a method or process in which supplemental income is consistently generated by establishing a business, growing, and learning.
5. **Prohibit large purchases:** there shall be no large unapproved purchases during 2026. Any large purchase (not already permitted under the directive) must be paid for through surplus funding. No investments in equipment for business development until it is proven to yield results. Surplus funding means money coming through avenues not already accounted for and appropriated for.

Section III – Travel Goals

1. **Out-of-State Requirement:** Travel to at least two destinations outside the State of Kansas shall occur between **April and October 2026**.
2. **Budget Restriction:** Total annual travel costs shall not exceed **\$2,300**. Multiple trips are permitted, provided the cumulative cost remains within this limit.
3. **Oversight:** All travel requests shall be reviewed and approved through the Financial Services Oversight Committee (FSOC) **docket process and the Office of Planning, Engagement, & Activity (OPEA) Request Process**.

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**Section IV – Education Goals**

1. **Certification Requirement:** At least one professional certification shall be obtained by **June 30, 2026**, in one of the following:
  - Data Analytics
  - Project Management
  - Or another similar discipline
2. Such a certificate shall be subject to FSOC approval.
3. **Academic Advancement:** The **Exploratory Committee for Educational Advancement** shall determine by **May 1, 2026**, whether enrollment for the **Fall 2026 academic term** shall occur in fields such as Public Administration, Economics, or another relevant discipline. Final approval shall be subject to **FSOC docket review**. If approved will require financial restructuring.

**Section V – Housing Goals**

1. **Relocation:** Move-out and relocation shall be considered on a quarterly basis to determine the appropriate course of action based on debt balances and established savings. The target of moving out shall be no later than **October 31, 2026**, with a target date of **September through October 2026**, permitting approval from the FSOC.

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**Section VI – Lifestyle Goals**

1. **Diet & Nutrition:** Reduce consumption of heavily processed foods, increase overall food consumption, and eat healthier foods.
2. **Cooking:** Learn to cook, cooking at least two meals per week.
3. **Exercise:** Exercise weekly.
4. **Get out of bed:** before 7:00 AM every day.
5. **Stay Active:** frequent bike rides and walks.
6. **Camping:** at least once per month during the warmer months.
7. **Read:** one book per month
8. **Film:** record and post memories as frequently as possible.

**Section VII - Administrative Regulation**

- New Regulations created and approved must wait at least two weeks before taking effect from the final approval date.
- The Office of Personal Prosperity has final authority over the regulation status.
- Approved amendments to existing regulations must wait at least one-month before becoming effective from the final approval date.
- Regulations that are approved to be repealed must wait at least one-month before becoming effective from the final approval date.
- Any approval for a regulation must be printed, signed, dated, and have an official “Approved” stamp on the document.
  - Such documents must be scanned and stored.

**Certification**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Personal Prosperity, having duly considered the foregoing, hereby enacts **Directive Resolution 264** as the official framework of goals and priorities for the year 2026.
